



## NHMEA Hall of Fame Application for Nomination

A framed certificate will be presented to the Hall of Fame recipients at the Spring All-Member Meeting, and their picture and biographical data will be published in the June issue of **Quarter Notes**. A plaque listing all the names of past recipients will be kept by the NHMEA historian.

The selection committee for this honor will be made up of the Past Presidents with the immediate past president acting as the chairperson for the committee. A ballot will be prepared and persons receiving 2/3 of the votes cast will be elected into the Hall of Fame. Any music educator holding current membership, past or present, active or inactive, alive or deceased, will be eligible for consideration.
